Layers of peeled logs are carefully dyed, reformed, re-cut and glued to create matching leaves. The result is a brilliantly finished product that provides outstanding consistency and endless inspiration.

FINISHING

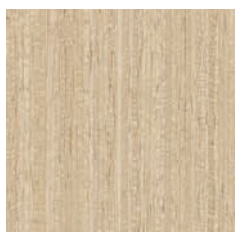
All Laminex® Designed Timber Veneer panels are supplied sanded, trimmed and unfinished, and will require polishing, allowing for customisation at the finishing phase. Please ensure the polishing instructions provided by the polish supplier are strictly adhered to. In addition to polishing, it is recommended that all panels are finished with a non-yellowing UV inhibitor and 2 pac polyurethane to protect the colour of the veneer. The same coating system and processing methods should be used across the entire project to ensure final colour consistency.

VENEER CUTS



Crown Cut pattern

Characterised by straight grain intermixed with Cathedrals - one of the most popular cuts.



Quarter Cut Rigato

This is a linear grain effect for a consistent veneer appearance.



Fineline

The fine grain of Fineline has been created to give a delicate, modest pattern. This ensures the colour of the veneer is highlighted.

BACKING OPTIONS

Timber Veneer panels are produced with three backing options.

Face 2 Sides	Same specified veneer both sides, high grade	F2S
1 Face / 1 Back	Same veneer but a lower grade on back	1F1B
1 Face any Back	Any veneer specie is used on back	1FAB
